Among 100 public figures consulted in the collection “A quoi sert la concurrence” edited by the Revue Concurrence, Matthieu Mélin contributed on intellectual property aspects

Matthieu Mélin, partner specialized in IP/IT issues, contributed to the collection “A quoi sert la concurrence ?” which gathers contributions from one hundred public figures including François Hollande and Nicolas Sarkozy, minister Michel Sapin and Arnaud Montebourg, several French and foreign university teachers as well as companies and their officers.
